FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY FALL BOOK SALE

The (somewhat) cooler temperatures and early-falling leaves are signs that autumn is not too far around the corner. That means it's time for the annual Friends of the Library Fall Book Sale at Fayette Public Library in La Grange.

This year's sale will run from September 29 through October 1. The Friends will set up shop in the conference room on the first floor of the library located at 855 South Jefferson (South US Highway 77) in La Grange. Sale times are Friday, September 29, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Saturday, September 30, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.; and Sunday, October 1, 2-5 p.m.

Friends of the Library members can shop early at a special evening event on Thursday, September 28, from 6-8 p.m. The public can gain admission to this pre-sale by joining the Friends of the Library. Memberships will be sold at the door, and annual dues are \$10 for individuals, \$15 for families, and \$3 for students 18 and under.

The Fall Book Sale features withdrawn library materials as well as donations from a generous public. About 75% of the items are donations, many of them in excellent "like new" condition. Book lovers will find thousands of hardcover books, paperbacks, children's books, and non-print (audio-visual) items — all priced to sell, most for 50 cents or less. Proceeds support various library projects and services.

It's not too late to donate your items for the sale, if you deliver them on or before Sunday, September 24. The Friends of the Library will accept hardbacks, paperbacks, and non-print items in good, sellable condition. Items no longer needed for the sale include magazines, Reader's Digest condensed books, college textbooks, and old encyclopedia sets.
