

UNIVERSIDAD Call for a Tenure Track Full-time professor position, for the **International Business Department at Universidad EAFIT**

The Department of International Business at the Universidad EAFIT is currently receiving applications from candidates to a tenure-track full-time position focused in the academic fields of International Relations and Economic Integration and Markets Access, during this second semester of 2021.

Universidad EAFIT

Universidad EAFIT was founded in 1960 as the first Colombian business school. Since then, it has grown to become a university with 13.156 students enrolled in 25 undergraduate programs, about 80 graduate programs (graduate certificates and masters), and 6 doctorate programs.

The Department of International Business

The Department of International Business, a leader in its field in Colombia, currently offers an innovative undergraduate program, with more than 1.000 enrolled students. Moreover, it offers a Master of International Business (MIB), totally delivered in English, as well as a graduate certificate in International Business Management. This department is a pioneer in the country conducting research on international business and its related fields. To consolidate its group of professors and researchers, this academic unit has an open call for applications for a tenuretrack full-time position in the academic fields related to International Relations, Economic Integration, and Market Access.

Professional Profile

A successful candidate is expected to:

- Teach courses in the undergraduate, graduate, and extension programs.
- Conduct research in the field of International Business and its related areas.
- Have an academic interest in the role of the international system as a scenario for designing and implementing the internationalization processes and in the influence of the organizations in the management of global challenges traditionally assigned to the States.
- Perform academic administration activities, including curriculum design.
- Publish books, chapters, and articles in relevant indexed scholarly databases endorsed by MinCiencias and internationally recognized.

The candidate must be able to deliver courses taught in English in the following areas:

- Introduction to international studies.
- International Comparative Studies
- Colombian International Agenda

- Trade diplomacy
- International Trade Agreements

Requirements:

- Ph.D. degree (or ABD status, close to obtaining the degree), in a program related to International Studies or International Relations, recognized in the field. In case the degree is obtained outside Colombia, it must be validated before the respective official institutions.
- English proficiency, with a minimum level of B2 (preferably C1), according to the CEFR.
- Spanish proficiency, with a minimum level of B2 in the DELE exam (if it is not your native language).
- Published academic works in indexed publications in the last 2 years.
- 3-year full-time teaching experience or 5-year professional experience.
- Specific knowledge and provable experience in topics related to international studies, international relations, and diplomacy, and/or the political, economic, social, and economic integration (trade liberalization) associated processes.
- The candidate must be able to teach undergraduate and graduate courses, as well as to develop research projects related to the areas mentioned above.

Interested candidates must provide the following documents:

- CV
- Cover letter
- Copy of the undergraduate degree. In case of being a degree issued abroad, it
 must be duly recognized and legalized before the competent body in Colombia.
- Copy of the graduate degree. In case of being a degree issued abroad, it must be duly recognized and legalized before the competent body in Colombia.
- Certificate(s) of academic teaching experience full-time or professional experience related to the academic and research areas of interest.
- Students' evaluations of the last year.
- Sample of published writing from the last 2 years that meets the following requirements: Academic papers published in indexed journals in the databases: ISI, SCOPUS, SCIELO, LATINDEX, PUBLINDEX. Academic books, lectures, research reports, software, course and academic programs design, patents, etc.
- Certificate of English proficiency B2 or C1 level, according to the CEFR.
- Certificate of Spanish proficiency if not the candidate's native language.
- 5-pages max. teaching and research statements referring to:

- Teaching performance (courses you can teach, development of teaching materials, involvement in the Institutional Educational Project, and the 2030 itinerary).
- Research (research topics, possible thesis topics, connection to groups and research areas of the Department of International Business, possible funding for your research, possible applications of theoretical knowledge, participation in national and international academic networks, and alliances).
- Social projection (possibilities and sectors of application in companies and government, extension, consulting).

Hiring conditions

- Type of contract: Fixed-term employment contract, for one year, with the
 possibility of extension for one more year or a switch to a long-term tenure-track
 contract, prior compliance with the established requirements in the Professorial
 Statutes of the Universidad EAFIT.
- Full-time position.
- Salary: Between (COP)\$5.990.276 and (COP)\$12.903.976 depending on the candidate's background and trajectory. 15 salaries are received annually, including legal and extralegal benefits granted by the University and other benefits for the employee and his/her family by the institution.
- Location: Main campus in Medellín (Colombia) with possible temporary trips to other cities or countries.

The resume review will start on September 1st, 2021 until the position is fulfilled.
