The manual xml-mkiv page 22 on \xmlchainatt reads:

"returns the value of attribute NAME or empty if no such attribute exists; backtracks till a match is found"

And next on \xmllastatt it reads:

"returns the last attribute found (this avoids a lookup)"

The last statement cannot be true because the attribute returned by \xmlchainatt is not retrieved with \xmllastatt, witness the following example.
